




# Yarning over tea; Sexual Health & HIV awareness

education thanks to the HIV grant.

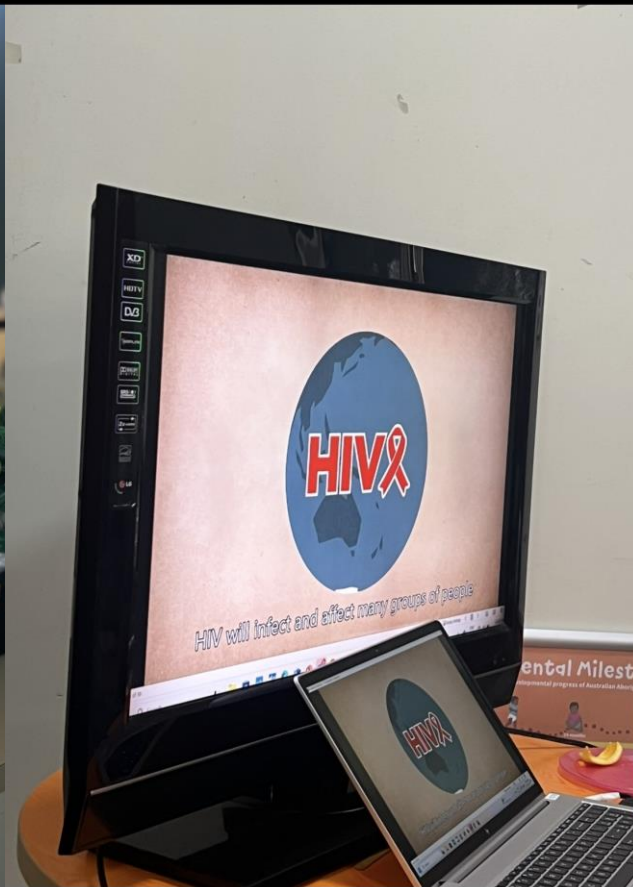
