

Cancer care snapshot

PHC's inpatient activity profile in 2022–23 included several cancer types. About 2,400 people were admitted to PHC with cancer-related diagnoses, resulting in:

- 5,800 admissions
- 8,500 bed days.

Admissions:

- 65% were medical in nature
- 13% related to surgical interventions
- 22% were non-surgical procedures (e.g. colonoscopies, endoscopies, and cystourethroscopies).

78% of Peel residents received their public chemotherapy at PHC.

Chemo unit activity

- Daily Medical Oncology Clinics (Mon-Fri)
- Once a week Haematology Clinic
- Chemo chairs 8
- Chemo unit opening hours 0700-1630
- Average treatments per day 25
- Infusions— Chemotherapy, Immunotherapy, Blood products, Iron infusions, Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) (neuro, immunology, gastroenterology, and haematology), Monoclonal antibodies to include other supporting specialities (neuro, immunology, gastroenterology, and haematology), Intravesical Bacillus Calmette-Guerin (BCG)

Referrals

- We receive referrals from Fiona Stanley Hospital (FSH), GPs and local surgeons/specialists.
- We receive usually 8 to 10 new medical oncology referrals per week.
- Our aim is to see new referral in 2-3 weeks and start treatment in 1-2 weeks.
- Majority of new patients are discussed in multidisciplinary teams (MDTs)
 either at FSH or PHC to formulate appropriate management plan.
- We have local Breast cancer MDT and Urological cancers MDT in Mandurah.
- Referrals can be sent to us directly on email, fax or through central referral system.

Diagnostic procedures

- Medical oncology service is not a diagnostic service, patients should be referred post tissue diagnosis. (Exceptions considered, when in doubt just call switch and talk to me or one of the oncologists for advice).
- There is limited capacity to do diagnostic procedures locally, some of the biopsies which can be done at Peel are
- Lymph node biopsies (Interventional Radiology IR)
- Liver biopsies (IR)
- Pleural fluid cytology (IR/Resp Physicians)
- Scopes (Gastroenterologists)
- Prostate biopsies (Urologist)
- Imaging guided lung/renal biopsies are not performed at Peel due to risks involved with these procedures.
- Rest should be referred to relevant specialties at FSH for establishing diagnosis and they will refer to medical oncology once diagnosis is made.
